








### Making sure that I get self care in order to do my job the best I can!




### I want to establish a positive relationship with as many students as I can particularly those who show signs of stress or those who are struggling.




### To disrupt the fixed mindset among students who believe that natural ability and personal traits, rather than effort, are the main traits in success.




### I'll form relationships with the kids that need it most.






