Monitoring Our Health

Quarantines

Students and staff who test positive will be required to quarantine per MDH guidelines.

Anyone who has a positive COVID-19 test shall not enter any District building or office, transportation, or activities, wherever located, until making a proper report to Nurse Shawnee at skrueger@sspps.org, 651-248-1005 and completing any necessary quarantine.

Face Coverings

- All students are required to wear a face covering indoors, unless they have a medical exemption.
- Face coverings are required for all people (students and staff), inside all SSPPS buildings and on all district transportation regardless of vaccination status. Face coverings are not required when outdoors.
